Both Beth and I have dealt with many health issues since we have been in the states. Some of these health issues are still unresolved for both Beth and me. Due to these issues our doctors would prefer that we stay close for a while longer, before thinking about leaving the states. As we have said before "our hearts are still in the Philippines" and we are still praying that the Lord would keep the door open for us to return sometime later this year after all the medical issues are sorted out if it is His will. We are asking that you, those that financially support us, would consider supporting us until the end of 2024 while we are waiting to see if we can return to the Philippines.
