Dear Pastors and friends,

It was so good to be back in Peru! Grace, Jonathan, Joshua, and Eliana were so excited to be there again, and the trip was full of nostalgic moments for us as they recognized sights, saw some old friends, and got to eat and drink some of their favorite things they have missed these last few years. Eddie was amazed to see how much they have grown. All four of them are taller than him now! Eddie and Lorena's wedding was beautiful. I was honored to be his best man and Grace was a beautiful bridesmaid. It was the most missions themed wedding I have ever seen! It was like a cross between a wedding and a missions conference. I am extremely encouraged about the future of the ministry there now that Eddie has "an help" who is "meet for him" in the work of the Lord. I again want to ask you all to consider supporting Eddie and Lorena in the work of missions. One family did respond to that request from my last prayer letter, and we are so grateful for that, but I am praying for more of you to join in having fruit to your account through Eddie's labors there in Peru.

The Lord did provide for the trip to India at the last minute! And at the last second, He provided for Pastor Jared Sostrom to join me! Jared and his wife Amanda attended our boot camp back in August and believe the Lord is leading them into the ministry of Itinerate Missions. It looks as if the Lord is using them to answer some of my prayers for more laborers to join me in this vision of preaching the gospel to "every creature which is under heaven" by following the apostles' pattern of mobile missions!

Our time in India was incredibly productive! Jared and I were able to preach in two churches a day the whole time we were in the state of Andrah Pradesh. And when the group of pastors and teachers we have been teaching over video chat found out where we were staying, they started showing up every morning for an unplanned Bible study! They are so hungry for the Word! The Lord worked it out that we were able to meet up with Missionary Kory Mears who "just happened" to be taking a trip to India to meet up with a group of men he has been discipling as well. His report of what God had been doing among the churches there was a great encouragement, and we were also able to fellowship and plan some ideas we have about future ministry and efforts to reach the unevangelized and uncontacted. There are some big plans and opportunities being formed and it is some thrilling stuff!

2024 is already shaping up to be a huge year for us. Besides the Who Will Go Camps (May 27- June 1 and June 3-8) in Alabama, the Beyond Borders boot camp (June 25-July 11) in Missouri, and the Ignite Youth Missions Conferences in Michigan (September) and Iowa (October), my family and I are planning to be in France from July 19-August 20 for the Olympic outreach and several other goals. That is a massive undertaking, and we are

trusting the Lord to provide all the resources necessary for that missions trip. We ask you to join us in praying for all of that!

I also want to ask you all to pray for my home church and our Bible College. Our college administrator is leaving to start a church in March, and our Pastor has asked if Rory and I could be the transition team to help get the college through this spring semester and train whomever the Lord provides to be the next Vice President. This is a lot to take on and I did not agree lightly, but after praying, fasting, and seeking the Lord's will, I am convinced that my church is in a bind, and it is good and right for us to help at this time. Please pray for us as we navigate these next few months and please pray that the Lord reveals the next man for the job soon.

Lastly, I ask that you pray with us as I try and plan a trip back to Honduras this spring. The Sostroms are praying about joining me on that trip and if that is the Lord's will, He will need to provide their needs and make the way clear as well. I would love to be able to introduce them to the Tolupan tribe and I am hoping the Lord will use them greatly in the future ministry there and in many of the other places I am working like Uganda, Peru, India, etc.
