Good news! I mentioned last month about Faith and Fern being lead to Christ by Debbie. They have been coming along with their grandfather who has also been saved. We also completed the purchase of our new Songthaew. This is a tremendous blessing for us! Thank you to those churches who contributed the funds for us to purchase a church vehicle. We appreciate it!

We had something difficult happen to us this month during the Loy Krathong Festival. (A festival to seek forgiveness from the goddess of water.) About 10 pm that evening we had our copper electrical wiring stolen from our building. The thieves cut the power at the street where our security cameras don't view. Once the power was cut the cameras go down. It cost me \$500 to replace the copper wiring with aluminum to make it less attractive to thieves. We are also installing a camera that will view that area. This is our second theft from our building.

Many are praying for us to find a suitable replacement for our main translator and unfortunately, we have not found that person yet. Please continue to pray as it is a pressing need for our ministry.
