From there I traveled down to Sanford, ME, to give a report to Calvary Baptist Church and be a part of their Refresher's Conference. I appreciate Pastor Bell letting me set up a table to be able to give information to Pastors in attendance about the work of BEST Missions. Pastor Chad Colburn introduced me to several pastors at the conference and helped me secure some meetings for the fall of 2025 when I will be back in the area. The Refresher's Conference was just that, refreshing! It was a blessing how the Lord worked in my heart through the preaching of His Word! Preachers need preaching too!

From Maine, we traveled back to Arkansas to give a report to a supporting church as well as our sending church, The middle of the month we loaded our 44th container of Scripture. 1,256 cases of John and Romans were loaded and will be sent to our distribution center in Bangkok. Sam Martin will be loading our 45th container of Scripture the week after Christmas with whole Bibles in Thai, Burmese, and English languages, along with Thai New Testaments, and John and Romans. These could not come at a better time as we only have nine cases of John and Romans left in Bangkok. The rest have gone or are going into the hands of young people in public schools as many churches will be doing Christian Christmas outreaches this month in the schools. Please pray for the Lord to work in hearts!

The Thai Bible project is almost finished in Thailand. I am looking forward to being there after the first of the year and receiving it and working to get these Bibles out to the churches. Please pray for traveling mercies for Amber and me as we head over. 2024 was a busy year and 2025 is shaping up to be another busy year. We must be busy until Jesus comes!
