Church planting in Macedonia

Dear Friends,

The Lord has been so gracious to our family. In my last email, I requested help with purchasing tracts, and while not all the money has come in yet, I have received reports that \$6,000 has been donated toward this project. Praise the Lord for this! My goal is now to print 50,000 gospel tracts, coloring books, and *The Redeemed* booklet. The Lord has also opened an incredible opportunity for a local college to help assemble the coloring book packets, providing a chance to present the gospel to students in Dallas. What an amazing God we serve!

The *Reaching Macedonia* missions trip is coming together. While I do not yet have an exact count, my goal was to bring 16 people this year, and we are now closer to 20! I had been praying for another driver, and while praying, I received a text from a young man saying he was looking for a place to serve and intern this summer! Praise God! I never cease to be amazed at how He always provides. There are significant costs associated with the trip, and if you would like to contribute and be a part of this mission, it would be greatly appreciated.

Many steps have been taken to design and produce new gospel tracts, as well as to redesign others that we realized did not fully match the culture. I have been teaching a Wednesday night class at my home church on reaching Muslims with the gospel. Though I have not yet ministered in a Muslim country, I asked my pastor for the opportunity to teach this class, which has challenged me to study more deeply. From these studies, *Aleksandar's Journey* was developed—a tract that directly addresses the objections Muslims are taught to raise against Christianity. I then hired someone on Fiverr to create a video for the tracts, and wouldn't you know—the lady who took the project is from Macedonia! The Lord has been working in every step, opening doors as I move forward. We are planning to visit her this summer.

I cannot express how excited I am to see the Lord at work. There are still some major tasks ahead. This week, I will be sending paperwork stateside to be apostilled and verified for submission to the Macedonian government for approval. Please pray for this process, the tract ministry, and the many who will be traveling in May. If you would like to support these projects financially, please let me know. And if you feel led to join us, we still have room for more laborers!
