Sulino and his wife were saved two weeks ago and baptized Sunday. An Air Force family got to see their teenage son baptized as well. The Lord continues to save souls here on the island.

The church in Yona also had a baptism last week on the opposite side of the island in Yona Bay, baptizing three as well. That work continues to grow and prosper. Praise the Lord!

Four of our teenage boys will be preaching for the first time this Wednesday evening. I am thrilled and excited to see what God will do in the future with these young men. Please pray for our Institute of Training that is to be started in the near future. We are praying that God will raise up some men to reach the other islands in our area.

In June, I am taking nineteen of our young people to Palau to hold five-day Bible clubs in three different villages. We will be gone from June 13th through June 20th. We will have an opportunity to reach relatives of our church members here in Guam who moved here from the islands of Palau.

The military moving off the island due to PCS orders is common. In our church, twelve have left in the last month with eight more scheduled to go next. We have to keep knocking, praying, and looking for prospects. What a wonderful ministry!
