Paperwork and Goverment

Upon arriving in Macedonia, we will begin the lengthy paperwork process to live there full-time. This process takes about six months. Due to government regulations, we must leave the country before the paperwork is finalized. During this time, we will submit the necessary paperwork and continue raising support. We plan to have everything in order by October and hope to move full-time at that point. Lord willing, we aim to begin holding services in early winter of 2025.
