Happy New Year! It is hard to believe that we are in 2026 already! Next month will mark the 20th anniversary of my survey trip to Peru in February of 2006. It is good to think about all God has done since that first incredible trip! Twenty years and nearly thirty countries later, my vision for missions, global evangelization, church planting, and laborer training is bigger than I ever would have dreamed back then. I am so grateful for all the Lord has let me see and do in His service, and I'm thrilled about the possibilities the coming years hold!

The last quarter of '25 went by in a flash. We had a blessed and memorable event in Flandreau S.D. with preaching and teaching as well as giving training sessions on some of the things we teach in our bootcamps, like a stop-the-bleed course, knife course, fire building, and compass reading. All topped off with great fellowship with Pastor and Mrs. Lillibridge, Pastor Yoder, Pastor Whittemore, and the folks at Faith Baptist Church.

The Great Lakes Ignite Youth Missions Conference was a huge blessing as well! We had an incredible group of young people and it is always such a blessing to get to team up with other missionaries and preachers to inspire and train the next generation of our churches members, missionaries and leaders.

Our Ignite Youth Missions Conference in Iowa was amazing too. The Lord used it in a mighty way, and I have gotten so much feedback about how the Lord worked in the hearts of many during the conference. For those of you who live near enough to Fort Dodge, we invite you to bring your young people out to the Ignite Youth Missions Conference October 5-6, 2026. We are already praying and planning for young people to be stirred up for the cause of "obedience to the faith among all nations for His name!"

Please pray for us as we head to Italy with the whole family for the Winter Olympics outreach in February. We are seeking the Lord for provision, protection, guidance, and fruit as we plan to travel through Italy, Slovenia, and Croatia handing out Gospel tracts and John and Romans! The Sostroms will be meeting up with us there and we will be teaming up to give out as many tracts, and John and Romans as we can. With the Olympics being hosted there, many people will be coming in from nearly every country in the World!

Next, we are planning a return trip to Iceland with the Sostroms and a group of others to blitz some of the rural areas of the country. Pray for us as we try and plan the logistics of that trip in June. I have been greatly encouraged to hear of several new missionaries on deputation to go to Iceland and churches planning their own missions trips there as well. I believe the Lord is planning something wonderful for Iceland. It cannot be a coincidence that at the same time He laid Iceland on our hearts about the unevangelized state of that country, He has been stirring up the hearts of dozens of others as well! There is no reason for Iceland to remain unevangelized. It is not a politically or religiously dangerous place. It is not very expensive to go there. It is super easy to take a quick trip there and anyone can go and give gospel tracts and witness to the people there. Most Icelanders speak excellent English, so the language barrier is not a major obstacle as it is in many other countries. We are praying that the Lord will stir up many more to go and share the Gospel in Iceland, even on short missions trips!

Please pray for Eddie and Lorena in Peru. They are still serving the Lord faithfully in the central jungle where we lived for 10 years, as well as taking trips all over Peru and Brazil. Lorena has had some medical issues and had to undergo surgery recently. Please pray for her recovery and for the Lord to bless them and provide for them in the ministry there.

We are planning for and praying over several trips this year. Please pray for the Lord to guide us and give wisdom about which trips to take and when to go. There are so many places I am longing to return to and so many other I greatly desire to reach into for the first time! Then we have our training events here in the States as well.

We will be running a Pioneer Missions Basic Training camp in July. I absolutely love getting to invest our years of experience in jungles, Islamic countries, urban and rural missions into young missionaries and future missionaries. The

bootcamps have been a life and ministry saver for hundreds of missionaries now going back through all the years of Beyond Borders camps and now with the PMBT camps. These camps are for older teens, college students, couples on deputation, or even veteran missionaries who want to be prepared to serve the Lord in the dark places of the Earth.

In August, Lord willing I will finally be able to return to the Batwa tribe in Uganda with Noah Bake. Noah is a graduate of both Beyond Borders and Pioneer Missions Basic training, and he was with me the first time I went to Uganda and preached to the Batwa. He is currently on deputation to go to Uganda and Congo to work among the “pygmy” tribes. We are planning to cross over into Congo for a quick exploratory trip as well as visiting and exhorting the Batwa believers in Uganda.

Somewhere between these trips and training events, I need to start scheduling meetings here in America. We have now been based in the States for eight years, and though we have had a chance to visit some of you between trips, we have not taken a block of time for a “furlough” to report back to our supporting churches and raise more supporting churches. I am so grateful for the faithfulness you all have shown us in your love, prayers, and support for all of these years! If any of you have a missions’ conference or would like to schedule a time for us to come and give an update in person, please let me know and we can try and work it into the schedule over the next year.
