What a joy it is to be able to serve the LORD. His goodness is overwhelming. These last few months have been very busy, yet very exciting. I have been in meetings in Virginia, North Carolina, Ohio, California, Texas, Utah, and Georgia. It is always thrilling seeing God work in people’s lives. Over the last couple of months, I have seen people come to faith in Christ, some surrender their lives and yet others just draw closer to Him!

Over the last 10 years I have watched a rise of anti-semitism in independent baptist churches. Yet since the war in Israel started 2 yrs ago, I have seen a rapid increase of antisemitism. This is a result of a false doctrine called replacement theology. Unfortunately, many are watching false teachers on social media platforms and are being led astray. The Lord has allowed me to help many churches across the country as I teach refuting this subject. On one of the trips, I was able to go to Utah and have a standing with Israel day. This church has received a lot of antisemitic responses since it started flying an Israel flag outside of the church. They simply wanted to show their support of Israel when the war started two years ago. The flag brought some negative attention from some yet some amazingly positive attention from others. I was blown away as the pastor told me of all the Jewish people who have

came by and thanked them for flying the Israeli flag, some of these were even from Israel. The church promoted this meeting in the Jewish community of Salt Lake City. I even flew an Israeli soldier and his son in from Israel to be in the meeting. It was an amazing 2 day event. As a result of the advertising, we did have a lost Israeli lady visit the service. She invited me and the other two Israelis that were with me over to her home for a meal after service. I had no idea that there would be so many Israelis show up that night. There were 10 people there from Israel, I was the only one not from Israel there. They were very intrigued and filled with questions about Baptist churches standing with Israel. The open door I had in talking about Jesus to them was absolutely amazing. There was one lady in particular who began to ask me several questions about my faith in Jesus. Everyone there was very receptive, but this lady is very close in receiving Jesus as her Messiah. Please be in prayer for Yifat.

All the family is doing well, we are very thankful for your prayers and ask that you continue to pray for us. On December 8, it will be the two-year anniversary of Dixie going home to be with the Lord. The Lord has been very gracious to us during this time, and I praise Him for it.
