April in Belgium is a very busy time for the farmers around here. We see them out in the fields day and night plowing two or three times, then planting the seeds, then spraying, then waiting for the rains to come. It's a good reminder for us that we need to be out planting the seed of the Word of God then pray for the seed to grow.

We've got back full swing into evangelism again now that spring is back. We had a couple of interesting stories last month. Joab moved back to the States last week so we decided to take one last road trip with him. We were at a little park and I took some tracts to put them in the door handles of the cars in the parking lot. One guy decided he didn't like that and instead of just throwing the tract away like some people do, he came over screamed at me for 2-3 minutes. He told me that Jesus would be embarrassed of me for putting "trash" on his car. I told him to just throw it away if he didn't like it, it was a gift to him, but he wouldn't let up. I was starting to wonder if he was going to get physical when Joab walked up, stood over the guy and said, "Get out of here and leave us alone". The guy took one look at him and quickly walked away. I knew I picked the right name for my oldest boy. I was perhaps a little disappointed he didn't pull out a sword like the Biblical Joab, but I'll take it. Last Saturday we went street preaching as a church, we were out there for an hour or so getting out a lot of tracts when an Arabic city worker approached Keira and got in her face about passing out tracts. He kept telling her it was illegal and that he was going to call the cops. She stood her ground and told him that she knew it was allowed to hand out pamphlets and asked him to show her where it said it is illegal. He just kept holding his phone threatening to call the police and telling her she was wrong. I had to quickly run over and confront him since he wasn't tough enough to confront a man. Sadly, Joab had already moved away by then or it might have been more interesting. The devil definitely didn't appreciate what we were doing this month, so we'll keep doing it!

Thank you for all you do for us, we are so grateful for the sacrifices you make to keep us on the field. We know that prices are rising and that's difficult on families so we don't take your support lightly and we are thankful for it.
