Greetings from Mexico! We are thankful for another opportunity to share what the Lord is doing here. We closed out the summer with many souls saved and baptized, and we have had the privilege of seeing people follow the Lord in baptism almost every week. We are also thankful for new members being added to the church. It is exciting to see the Lord continue to work and bring new people into the church.

Our fall semester at Instituto Bíblico Bautista Monte Hebrón is now underway with 49 Bible college students preparing to serve the Lord. We are thankful for each Christian worker God has sent our way.

With that growth comes our biggest prayer request: we need more dormitory space! Our men's dorm is completely full with 23 men, and our women's dorm is full with 18 ladies. We are making plans to break ground on new dormitories so that we will have room for the students coming next fall. Please pray that God will provide the finances needed to begin construction soon. We are excited about the growth and want to be ready for whoever the Lord sends us.

Our bus ministry is growing as well. Beginning this month, we are adding another rented bus to our Sunday routes at a weekly cost of \$138USD. Please pray that God will use this additional bus to help us reach more children, adults, and families with the Gospel.

Our family is doing well and enjoying good health. The kids are excited about beginning another school year. Jenny is homeschooling two days a week, and Paola Solis is helping teach them at the church. She has been a tremendous blessing to our family and ministry.

We also want to thank those who helped our assistant pastor, Carlos Cancino, raise money for his daughter's U.S. paperwork. We are happy to report that she has been approved as a U.S. citizen! They now have an appointment within the next year to continue the process and still need about \$400 for the remaining documentation. Thank you to everyone who has already helped with this need.

Thank you for faithfully praying, giving, and standing behind the work here in Mexico. The church is growing, Christian workers are being trained, and souls are being saved. We are grateful that you have a part in all that God is doing here.
