One project that had been needed for quite some time was replacing the front steps to our church. For years, our entrance consisted of wooden pallets resting on concrete blocks. While they served their purpose for a time, they had become unstable and were especially difficult for many of our elderly folks to use. We were thankful to finally replace them with a sturdy set of wooden steps that provides a much safer entrance for our church family and visitors.

The Lord also opened another opportunity to serve when a lady connected with our church lost her home in a devastating fire. Her family organized a cleanup day, and my boys and I were thankful to spend the day helping remove debris and clean the property. Although we were the only ones from our church able to help that day, it was a blessing to demonstrate Christ's love through practical service during a very difficult time.

Mother's Day was another special blessing during the month of May. We honored the mothers of our church with small gifts and created a photo backdrop where families could take pictures together after the service. It was a simple way to recognize the faithful ladies who are such an important part of our church family.

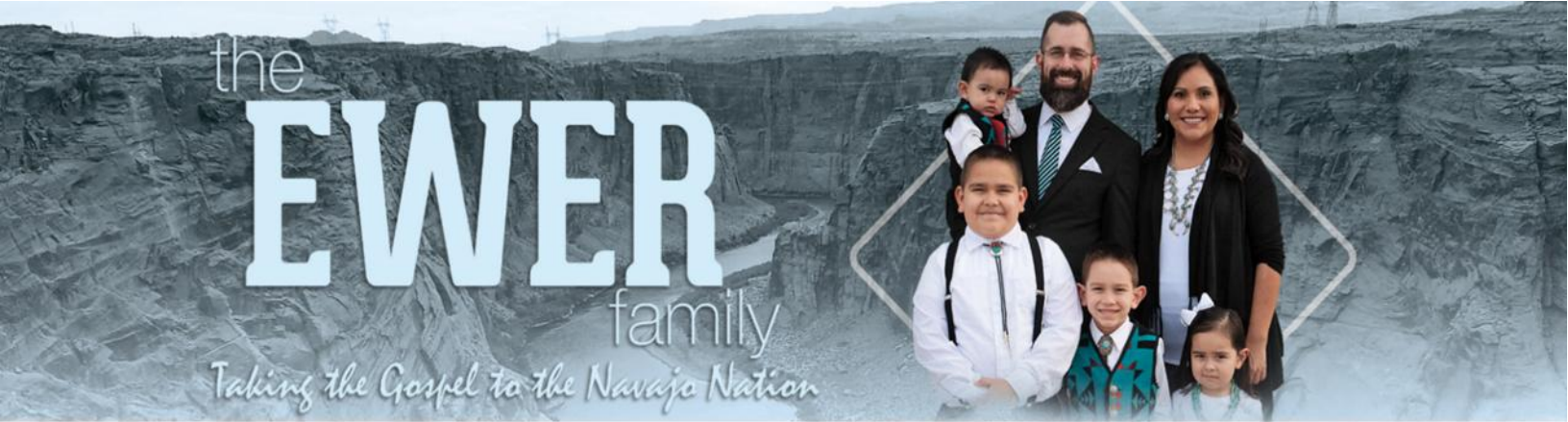

I had the opportunity to preach the funeral service for **Chris**, a man who had attended our church. We were also encouraged to welcome **a first-time visitor** to our Sunday morning service. Please pray that she will continue attending and that the Lord will continue working in her life.

One of the greatest blessings this month was our annual summer camps. Because attendance has continued to grow, this year we held **two separate weeks of camp**—one for younger children and another for teenagers. Our church was able to send **five campers to Junior Camp** and **six to Teen Camp**. Most importantly, **five young people trusted Christ as their Saviour** during the two weeks of camp! We praise the Lord for each of these decisions and ask you to pray that they will continue to grow in their walk with Him.

Camp also brought an unexpected change. **Pastor Bob Gray**, our scheduled speaker, was involved in an accident on the second day and had to return home to Texas. Thankfully, the Lord protected him, and I had the privilege of preaching one of the services of camp. I was honored to have the opportunity to preach.

Sheena, faithfully prepared every meal for both weeks of camp, cooking for **more than 300 people**. Her long hours of service behind the scenes made it possible for camp to run smoothly, and I am thankful for her servant's heart.

Finally, we are excited to share that **our July payment will completely pay off our church building!** We praise the Lord for His faithful provision. Our next major prayer request is obtaining a permanent land lease so the building can be placed on church property.
