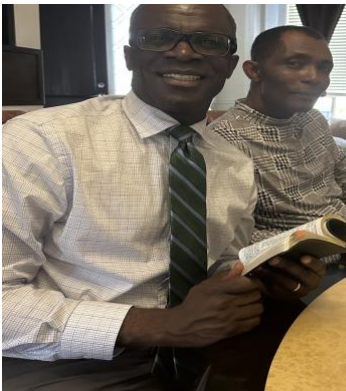




Dear Pastor and Church Family,

Others have previously attended churches that do not clearly preach the Gospel and were baptized without ever personally receiving Christ as Savior.

When we share the Gospel with them and teach them that biblical baptism comes after salvation, they often respond, "I have already been baptized."

Please pray that God will work in their hearts and help them understand the simple truth of the Word of God concerning salvation and believer's baptism.

Prayer Requests Please continue praying for Haiti. Two weeks ago, gangs killed more than 40 Haitians, including women and children, and kidnapped more than 50 people in western Haiti. Please pray for God's protection, peace, and deliverance for the people of Haiti. Please also continue praying for my wife's spousal visa. Pray that the Lord will guide the process and allow everything to move forward according to His will. Thank you again for your faithful prayers and support.
