It has been a busy and fruitful summer here in the Dominican Republic. We have seen first-time and returning visitors, increased attendance, and, most importantly, souls saved in both churches. As the summer comes to a close, we are thankful not only for the activities, but especially for the spiritual decisions and opportunities for discipleship that have come from them.

Summer Camp

One of the highlights of August was taking 11 of our teenagers to camp. Earlier this year, a fellow missionary reached out about organizing a camp for young people from several churches. Because it was a smaller group, we were able to spend more personal time with our teens and focus on their spiritual needs.



It was encouraging to see the Lord work. One of our teens was saved, several committed to reading their Bibles and praying daily, and one of our young men surrendered to preach. Across all the churches represented, 8 souls were saved, 8 surrendered to preach, 2 surrendered to full-time Christian service, and 9 rededicated their lives to the Lord.



We were also thankful to have Bro. and Mrs. Tripp from our sending church, Woodlawn Baptist Church, invest in our young people through preaching, teaching, and personal encouragement.
